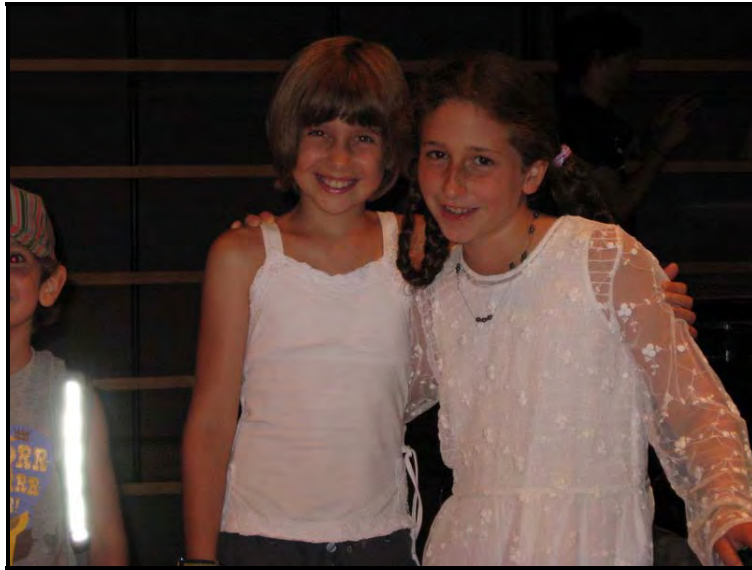
During group lessons, the teacher we had was called Christophe.
